




# **GEORGIA STATE** \*\*Form Information/Directions\*\*

## What are the 500/600/700 Clubs?

The clubs perform two purposes:

- Recognize youth bowlers for exceptional scoring.
- Gain entry into the annual 500/600 Handicap and 700 Scratch Club Tournaments. Tournament is held in early August.



## What scores qualify?

To qualify, scores must meet the following criteria:

- Athlete is a youth member of the Georgia State USBC.
- Scores are 3 game SCRATCH series (the league can be handicap based, but the score must qualify before handicap is added).
- Either bowled during league or tournament play, providing it was a USBC sanctioned activity held in the state of Georgia.
- If league, the score CANNOT be from pre or post bowling.
- If tournament, the score must be the first three games of a given block/event.

### How long is an athlete a member of the club?

Club membership applies to the duration of the athlete's youth bowling career. They have perpetual access to the annual tournament. That said, once an athlete qualifies for the 600/700 Club, they are no longer a member of the 500/600 Club, and can no longer compete in that division in the annual tournament.

### When should forms be submitted and by whom?

Forms should be submitted by the league or tournament official. They can be submitted at the time qualifying score is bowled (encouraged) or at the end of the season. Forms do not need to be resubmitted for athletes that have qualified in seasons past, unless the athlete is moving up from 500/600 to 600/700.

Verification of scores (league standing sheets) must ALSO accompany this form.
