TEAM CAPTAIN – EACH TEAM MEMBER SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- 1. The entry cost per person, per event shall be, prize fee \$12.00, lineage and tournament expenses fee \$18.00, total fee \$30.00. Prize fund will be paid out on the basis of at least one prize for every ten (10) entries to handicap winners in each Division. The Scratch All Events Division entry fee will be two dollars (\$2.00) and the Handicap All Events Division entry fee will be one dollar (\$1.00). Prize checks will be sent to the team captains within thirty (30) days after the close of the Tournament. Prizes for all events will be based on number of entries.
- 2. All entrants in the Georgia State USBC Womens Championship Tournament must be members in good standing in their local association, Georgia State USBC, and the USBC. Only 2 team members or 1 doubles partner from an association outside of the Ga State USBC will be allowed per team or doubles pair. Any bowler under the age of 18 years of age must comply with Rule 13, USBC Rule Book. The Annual Tournament will be a handicap tournament and handicap will be figured on the basis of 90% of the difference between the highest average of the individual and 230. The team event will be divided into two divisions. Division I shall include all teams having an average of less than 620. The Doubles and Singles will be divided into two divisions. Division I in the doubles will include all those doubles with an average of 310 or better and in the singles will include all those with an average of 155 or better. Division II in the doubles will include all doubles with an average of less than 310 and in the singles will include all those with an average of less than 155. Handicap All Events will be divided into two divisions. Division I will include all those with an average of 155 or better and Division II will include all those with an average of less than 155.
- 3. AVERAGE RULE—Entrants in the Georgia State USBC Women's Tournament shall use their highest 2022-2023 certified USBC final average for 21 games or more. If no previous average, the highest current average as of January 1, 2024 for 21 games or more in one league shall be used. (Submit or bring a signed verification of 1/1/2024 average.) An entrant without a 21 game average as of January 1, 2024 may use her highest <u>USBC</u> certified league average for at least 12 games subject to the approval of the tournament manager. Any bowler who has only an average bowled on a **Sport Condition whether certified as a Sport League or not** must use the adjusted Sport average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. **ALL OTHERS BOWL SCRATCH.** (**USBC Rule No. 319a(2) will not apply**). BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THEIR OWN AVERAGE. See **Rule 319a(3**). You must report prize winnings of \$300 or more in any event, \$500 or more in any tournament and \$1000 in all tournaments in the previous 12 months(**USBC Rule 319d**) at checkin. You must adjust your entering average if your tournament average over the past 12 months for 21 games or more is 15 or more pins higher than your entering average (**USBC Rule 319e**). All entrants are required to report re-rate or adjustments to averages from any other tournament. Failure to report any of these is cause for disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings..
- 4. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION IS ALLOWED.. Multiple entries are allowed in Team and Doubles/Single Events. However, no more than two of the same members may bowl on the second team event and 1 of the same members on the second doubles. A bowler entering doubles a second time must also bowl singles a second time. You can cash only once in singles. First appearance shall count for All Events.
- 5. No change will be made in the entrants' schedule time, except in the case of emergency and must be approved by the Tournament Manager. Substitutes will be allowed and must be made two hours prior to the scheduled bowling time with verification of average. Substitutions made because of emergency are subject to approval of the Tournament Manager. In case of disability, after a game has started, a substitute will be permitted if available, and the continued score shall count. This applies in the team and doubles events only. If a replacement is needed on each of two double teams, the two entrants present may be paired together.

RULES CONTINUED:

- 6. An entrant arriving late will be permitted to bowl, with her scores to count beginning with the frame in which she begins to bowl. Doubles Events will be bowled first. Bowlers will remain on same lanes for doubles and singles.
- 7. When a team is scheduled by itself on a pair of lanes, each member will complete the frame on one lane before the team shall start its next frame on the adjoining lane. NO PACERS SHALL BE PERMITTED
- 8. Dress Code: Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during the tournament. All clothing must be neat, clean,and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly or sash collars, or t-shirts. Acceptable bottoms include pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts, skirts and/or skorts (the length of these items should be at least to your fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides). Hats and headgear are allowed. The following is not allowed: leggings, tank tops, short-shorts, swimsuits, spandex, and ragged attire. All decisions of proper attire will remain with the tournament manager.
- 9. Each entrant must have a bowling ball for her individual use in the Tournament.
- 10. Smoking and E-cigarettes are not permitted while bowling in any event of the tournament. Entrants are not permitted to eat or drink in the bowling area while participating in any bowling event. Violators will be subject to disqualification.
- 11. Entrants will not be permitted to leave the lane on which they are bowling except in an emergency. Misconduct of a member will not be permitted and a member may be prevented from beginning or continuing to bowl and must forfeit those games and shall be dismissed from the bowling establishment. The decision of the officers in charge shall be final.
- 12. Tournament entrants who do not bowl in the order listed on the entry blank shall be disqualified. Any substitute(s) must take the place of the absent bowler(s). (Teams MUST report to the Tournament office not less than thirty (30) minutes before they are scheduled to bowl. Member's USBC cards must be presented at each check-in time.)
- 13. Georgia State USBC shall have full power to hear and determine all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the Georgia State USBC Association Tournament. Any protest(s) regarding scores must be made in writing to the State President or State Association Manager and must be submitted not later than twenty-four (24) hours after the game(s) has been bowled. Any malfunction of equipment should be reported immediately to the Tournament Manager(s). The action of the Tournament Manager(s) shall be final. If a tie for first place occurs in any event, co-champions shall be declared and duplicate awards will be given.
- 14. Tournament games cannot be rebowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device.
- 15. The tournament recap sheet will be the official score sheet. Scores will be verified from the automatic score printouts.
- 16. Additional squads may be added during the course of the tournament as deemed necessary by tournament management, but no squad shall be added after the last advertised squad time. Entries received after the closing date may be accepted to fill openings in any shift.
- 17. Bowlers requiring aids, such as crutches, canes, wheelchairs, etc. or who are blind, must report this in writing when form is filed so that special scheduling consideration can be arranged. Similar advance notice must be given if such a bowler with special needs is to be used as a substitute. Any bowler requesting a dress code exception must do so in writing and have a written doctor's excuse.
- 18. Any rule not addressed in these rules will be covered by the USBC Rule Book.

The officers and agents of the Georgia State USBC shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule changes, or premature termination of the tournament.
