Georgia State USBC Annual Queens Tournament Rules

45th Queens, 24th Senior Queens & 6th Super Senior Queens

Retain Tournament Rules for Reference

Tournament Rules- USBC Certified

1. Female members of the Georgia State USBC with an GA adult certified 160 average or higher are eligible to participate in the Georgia State USBC Queens, Senior Queens or Super Senior Queens Tournament. Past participants who no longer carry a 160 average or no longer live in GA will be allowed to bowl in the current tournament provided they have participated in any Georgia Queens Tournaments since 1988. All others are excluded. Postmark date to determine accepted entries. Average as of January 1, 2026 of 21 games or more will be allowed provided it is verified with entry. Members age as of February 14, 2026 will determine eligibility to enter Senior Queens or Super Senior Queens Tournament

2. Entry Fee will be \$75.00 for Queens/Senior Queens and \$70.00 for Super Senior Queens. Queen/Senior Queen Expense/Bowling Fee: \$35.00-National Fund: \$5.00 - Prize Fund: \$35.00. Super Senior Queen Expense/Bowling Fee: \$35.00 - Prize fund: \$35.00
A \$30.00 fee will be added for any returned personal checks. No cash please!
All prize monies will be returned 100% and will be presented at the conclusion of bowling during the crowning ceremony on March 1, 2026.

3. All entrants will draw for lanes. Queens, Senior and Super Senior Queens will bowl together on Saturday with scores being kept separately. On Sunday the Semi-finals and Stepladder finals will be separated by Queens, Senior and Super Senior Queens

4. All entrants will bowl four **(4) games** across eight (8) lanes on Saturday, February 28, 2026. At the end of the four (4) games, the number will be cut by 60%. If odd number, the number will be rounded up. The top 40% will return on Sunday, March 1, 2026 to bowl the Semi-Finals. Scores from the qualifying squad **will** carry over to the Semi-Finals.

Semi-Finals - Lanes will once again be drawn. Bowler will bowl three games across six (6) lanes. Scores from Saturday plus pins for the three (3) game set will determine the top five (5) positions.

Finals - Bowlers in the top five (5) positions will bowl in one (1) games Stepladder finals. In case of a tie for any roll-off position, a two frame roll-off will be held.

The Player in position #5 will bowl against player in position #4. The winner bowls against player in position #3, while the loser finishes fifth.

The winner of the second match bowls against player in position #3 while the loser finishes fourth.

The winner of the third match bowls against player in position #2 while the loser finishes third.

Rule 4 continued

The winner of the final match is the 2026 Georgia State USBC Queen/Senior Queen and Super Senior Queen, while the loser finishes second.

5. Contestant MUST report no later than one-half (1/2) hour prior to shift time and must show current USBC card or a paid receipt. Entry will be confirmed.
6. Qualified subs within the same division will be allowed with written consent of original entrant.
7. Participants may enter tournament only once. Check box on page two of the entry form to indicate the division you want to enter.
8. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by reason beyond the control of the Georgia State USBC shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be pro-rated in accordance with with the number of entrants who have bowled.
9. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager, when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device.
10. The Queens Management will act upon any problems that are not covered in these rules. The decision of the Queens Management will be final.

11. Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during the tournament. All clothing must be neat, clean, and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly or sash collars, or t-shirts. Acceptable bottoms included pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts, skirts and/or skorts (the length of these items should be at least to your fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides.) Hats and headgear are allowed. The following is not allowed: tank tops, short-shorts, swimsuits, and ragged attire. All decisions or proper attire will remain with the tournament manager.

Reigning Queen, Senior & Super Senior Queen will have her entry fee paid by the GA State USBC for the next year's Queens, Senior & Super Senior Queens tournament and participate in the tournament as any other participants. She must mail in an entry form in order for the tournament manager to know that she intends to bowl.

BRACKETS WILL BE RUN BY HOST ASSOCIATION

Winner for Queen/Senior Queen will be eligible to be sent to Nationals with adequate participation in this tournament.
